Rohtang Pass


Rohtang Pass is a popular travel destination that wins tourist's hearts with its winsome natural beau-

Atal Tunnel

Atal Tunnel is a horseshoe-shaped highway tunnel that connects Manali and the Lahaul-Spiti valley, reducing the time taken by around 4-5 hours.

Named after the former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee, the tunnel is the world's longest one above 10,000 feet and is constructed in the Pir Panjal ranges, under the Rohtang Pass. The tunnel's North End brings visitors into Sissu, which is surrounded by high peaks.





Hadimba Temple

Hadimba Temple is one of the famous attractions in Manali. It is dedicated to Hadimba Devi, the consort

of Bhim, the second among the five Pandava brothers. The temple is thronged with tourist traffic during

the celebration of Navratri festival.







Vashisht Temple

Vashisht Temple is an ancient historic holy shrine said to be around 4000 years old. The place is dedicated to Rishi Vashisht, the mentor of Lord Ram & Laxman from Ramayana. The hot water springs here have magical healing properties to cure skin diseases. There are separate bath spaces for men & women.





Mall Road

Bustling street flanked by numerous hotels, restaurants, dhabas, booths, and shopping options, Mall Road is considered the soul of Manali. It is an ideal place to start exploring Manali, full of many activities that will get you engaged throughout the day. The Mall Road Manali embodies the charm of the hill town in all its glory. There is a tonne of boutiques and antique shops lined up in this well-known shopping street where you can find some excellent souvenirs.








Jogini Waterfall

Jogini Falls is a streaming waterfall cascading down to join the river Beas in the Kullu Valley. It is a sacred place dedicated to the goddess Jogini, a female power, also called Shakti Peeth. The temple of the

goddess is located at the base of the waterfall.





Manali Wildlife Sanctuary

The exquisite greenery and the presence of wild mountain animals make the Manali Wildlife Sanctuary one of the must see destinations in Manali. Established in the year 1954, the Manali Wildlife Sanctuary includes animals like the Himalayan Black Bear, Musk Deer, Flying Fox, Stripped Hyena, Himalayan Tahr, Indian Hare, Barking Deer, Palm Civet, Serows, Himalayan Yellow Throated Martens, and Kashmir Flying Squirrels. The rich forest of this Manali sanctuary is covered with trees like Deodar, Horse Chestnut, Kail, Maple, and Walnut.









Museum of Himachal Culture & Folk Art

The Museum is a unique and extraordinary collection of unknown and rare antiques of the state.

It demonstrates the almost extinct articles that clearly display the forgotten culture, art and handicraft

of Himachal Pradesh.







Old Manali

Old Manali is a charming, laid-back district known for its wooded mountain trails, apple orchards, and scenic spots by the Manaslu River. It's dotted with quaint backpacker lodgings and bohemian cafes serving global fare, grilled trout, and pancake breakfasts, while souvenir shops sell hand-knitted woolens and dreamcatchers.






Manu Temple, Old Manali

Dedicated to the Indian sage Manu, this temple is the only temple on this planet that is dedicated to this sage. Thus it makes to be one of the most sacred pilgrimages for the devotees of this saint. Built with wood and stone, the temple offers exotic views of the Beas River and magnificent hills. In front of the temple, a huge cascade enhances the aesthetics of this resplendent temple.





Van Vihar National Park

One of the most frequent places to visit in Manali, the Van Vihar National Park attracts visitors mainly because of its ideal location, which is bang on the Mall road in Manali. The park is a welcome respite from the crowds and the pollution with its tall and shady groves of Deodar, birch and pine. There are a number of wooden and concrete benches within the park, which provide rest, relaxation and recreation to its visitors.





Himalayan Nyinmapa Buddhist Monastery

- This historic Monastery with a Pagoda-styled design is one of the main tourist attractions in Manali.
- The fascinating architecture of Tibetan style is worth praising. The parts that make this temple so
- famous are Lord Buddha's huge two-storey-tall statue, and eye-catching wall paintings that it houses.
- For the serenity and positivity that fills this place visit this temple.







Nehru Kund

The Nehru Kund is a natural spring which was named after the first prime minister of India Late Pundit Jawaharlal Nehru. The graceful clean water spring is said to have its source at the Bhrigu Lake. The sound of the bubbling water amidst the peaceful silence of the place will play like music to your ears. The river Beas flows through it. The serenity of the place and crystal clear water of the Kund attracts the tourists who visit Manali.
