Ranthambore Experiences



Birding

Along with a rich variety of fauna, Ranthambore is also home to a large number of birds making it an important birding destination in India. The national park in Rajasthan which is popular for being a natural habitat for Royal Bengal Tiger is also home to around 320 species of birds that include Serpent Eagle, Waterfowl, Cormorant, Painted Spurfowl, Sarus Crane, Bronzed-Winged Jacana, Sandpiper, Kingfisher, Nightjar, Painted Sandgrouse and Great-Horned Owl.

A large number of migratory birds in the winter season also make Ranthambore and its wetlands their home giving bird lovers and ornithologists reasons enough to visit the national park. Most of the birds inhabit the areas around the three large lakes – Padam Talao, Malik Talao and Rajbagh Talao.



Photography

Ranthambore national park, located in the indian state of rajasthan, is a haven for wildlife enthusiasts and photographers alike. With its diverse range of flora and fauna, including the majestic royal bengal tigers, Ranthambore offers incredible opportunities for capturing stunning photographs. 3 hours shared Safari in Ranthambore Tiger Reserve

Travellers short on time in the Ranthambore area still have the chance to spot tigers by joining a handy 3 hours group safari tour. Save time with a pick-up from the Hotel, from where you'll head to Ranthambore National Park. Tour in a rugged Jeep, and follow trails through the jungle that give you a good chance of seeing tigers, as well as other animals and birds. Look out for Royal Bengal Tigers as well as other animals such as leopards, sloth bears, deer, and lots of birds. This is a full-day tour and the safari itself lasts around 3 hours.

National Chambal Safari & Alligator Sighting

You will be picked up from your hotel for the drive to the National Chambal Sanctuary and enjoy the countryside as you go past villages and fields. Spread over 5,180 sq. km., the sanctuary is home to several endangered species like the Blackbuck, Gharial, Red Crown Roofed Turtle and River Dolphin. The River Chambal cuts through the sanctuary. Spend the time in spotting the endangered Blackbuck. Once your tour will be finished you will be driven back to a fixed point / your hotel in Sawai Madhopur.

Climbing these stairs, one almost feels as if the fort is a living entity, whispering tales of its colourful past. Lots of Langurs (white-bodied monkeys with a black face) have now taken up residence in the fort. While the monkeys are supposedly friendly, it's best not to get too close to them.

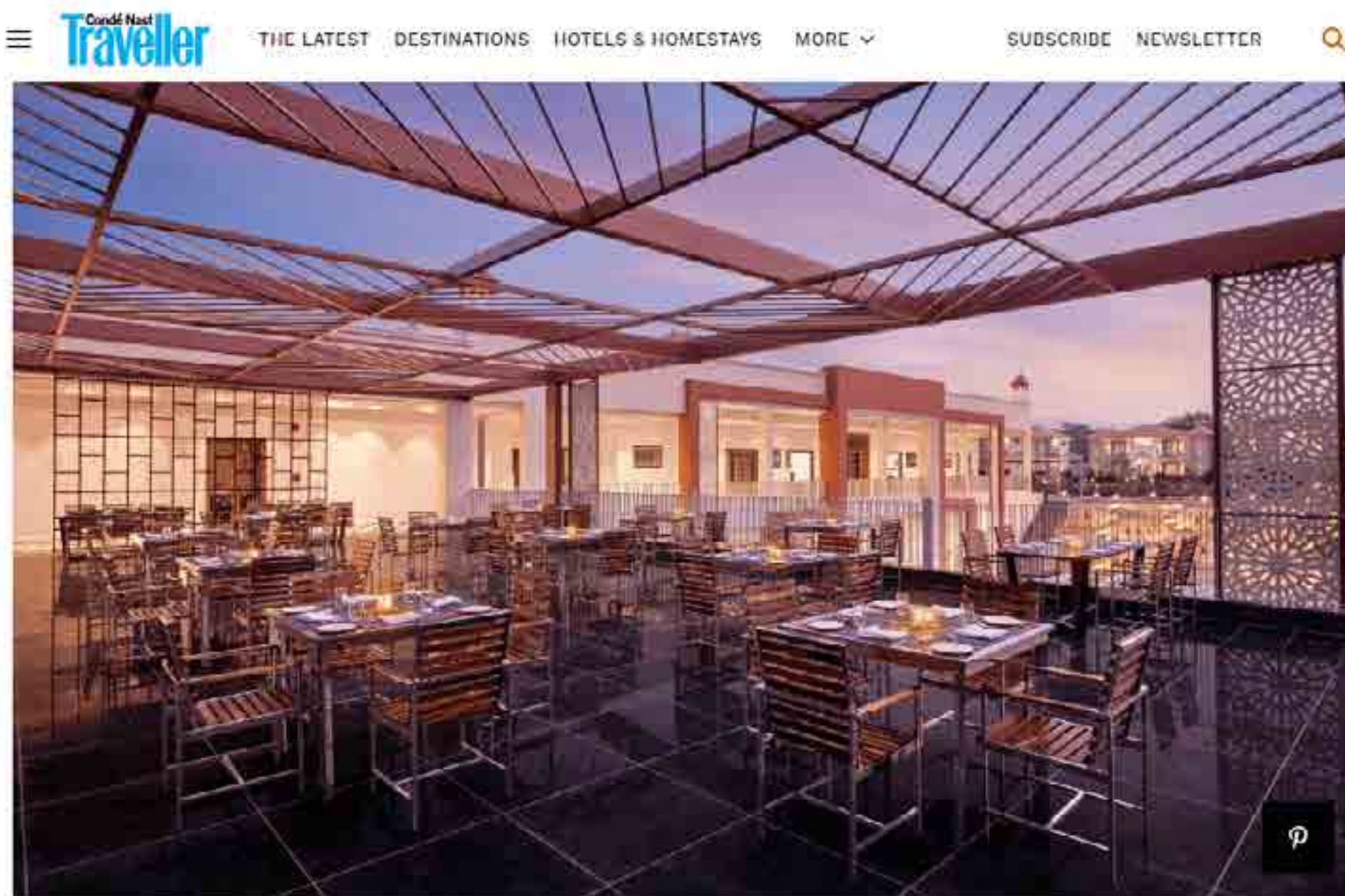

Fort runner

Situated just a few kilometres away from the luxurious Bookmark Resort Jogi Mahal, the Ranthambore fort beckons with its spectacular views

Scrampering around a makeshift temple in interior Rajasthan, squirrels share a fort wall with langurs. Jungle hikers take quite a din. The Ranthambore fort seems to have been taken over by a variety of wild creatures, big and small. Nestled inside the popular Ranthambore National Park, the magnificent structure stands near the city of Sawai Madhopur and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is said to have been constructed by Maharaja Jayama in the 5th century AD. One of the state's largest forts, it covers almost seven square kilometres and is perched atop a 700-ft-high hill. The grand walls and corridors, nooks and crannies, which once stood tall and proud are weathered with time, but look carefully and you can see the shadow of the past.

From a vantage point on the fort, the dense dhok tree-laden forest below resembles a carpet in different hues of green. In the distance, the sun's rays ripple on the Padam Talao, the lotus lake. The former hunting lodge Jogi Mahal, which was once a favourite of the Maharajas of Jaipur, is situated on the banks of the lake. Nadeem, the park naturalist, shares that the resident tigress Rudhi loves to bring her three cubs to the ruins of the Mahal, especially during summers. On the road leading to the fort, or while returning, you could spot a tiger if you are lucky.

The steps of time : How ancient stepwells are inspiring modern structures and design

From educational institutions and resorts to rugs and art, baoris are having a moment of revival

Decades later, true to their word, they have combined the functional, social and spiritual aspects of a stepwell for the students of Sanskriti Vihara building at the SJ Somaiya Educational Trust campus in Mumbai. "It was a latent memory that instantly came to the fore in our minds," Panjabi says of the invitational competition to design the building about 10 years ago. Currently under construction, it should be ready in time before the new academic year begins in May 2025, and "students will be able to walk the actual facade of the building instead of being inside".

From a minimalistic utilitarian character during the Indus Valley Civilisation to post-seventh-century plunging ornate structures that still elicit awe, stepwells have always been a part of Indian architectural consciousness. And right now they seem to be having a revival moment, not just in architecture but also in design and art.

Ancient wisdom, modern leisure

Amid the neutral and monochromatic canvas of Bookmark Resort Jogi Mahal in Ranthambore, that started operations in January 2024, the wall near the swimming pool provides a dreamy backdrop. The wall, inspired from Abhaner's Chand Baori in Rajasthan, one of the most famous, deepest, largest, and oldest stepwells in India, not only displays a fine game of shadows with every passing moment but also brings guests together in the evenings by becoming a stage for folk artists.

naturalists, wildlife buffs and photographers unfurled their long lenses and there was a flurry of clicks. Two more cubs strolled in, followed by a graceful tigress. Suddenly, all around us, jeeps were jockeying into position, engines starting and revving, disturbing the big cats who slowly vanished into the thicker.

Continuing our safari, we passed a glassy water body with the remnants of a royal pavilion. Here, chital milled around with high-stepping grace while a serpent eagle obligingly posed for our cameras. However, it was at Raj Bagh Talab that Ranthambore treated us to its most jaw-dropping cancos. As the setting sun slowly bled into the limpid waters, it softly illuminated the arches of a forgotten pavilion. A herd of sambar wallowed in the water, their magnificent antlers draped with weeds. The lake glowed with hues of red and green algae and above, birds flitted in joyful abandon. The scene resembled a painting by a divine artist.


Back at our hotel, Bookmark Resorts Jogi Mahal, the jungle theme continued with lush murals adorning the public areas and the artworks embellishing the rooms and suites. As we slumbered in our plush environs that night, we imagined Machli, the legendary tigress of Ranthambore, striding innocently across the lawns, and wildlife tableaux unspooling within

Ranthambore National Park, located in the Sawai Madhopur district of Rajasthan, is approximately 145 km from the nearest airport in Jaipur. The park offers wildlife sightings and is best visited from November to March, although some zones are open during the monsoon season as well. April-May, despite being hot, presents excellent opportunities for wildlife sightings around remaining waterholes.



Visitors must book safaris in advance either in a private jeep or a center through the park's website or by phone. Bookmark Resorts Jogi Mahal offers luxury accommodations with villas featuring private plunge pools, outdoor showers, and mountain views. Other high-end options include Sawai Madhopur Lodge, The Oberoi Vanyavilas, Sher Bagh, and Aman-i-Khas. More information can be found on the park's website.

Located in close proximity to the national park, yet enclosed in a quiet charmed space of its own, the 40 rooms (including suites) are located in a cluster of 10 villas, some come with heated private plunge pools and

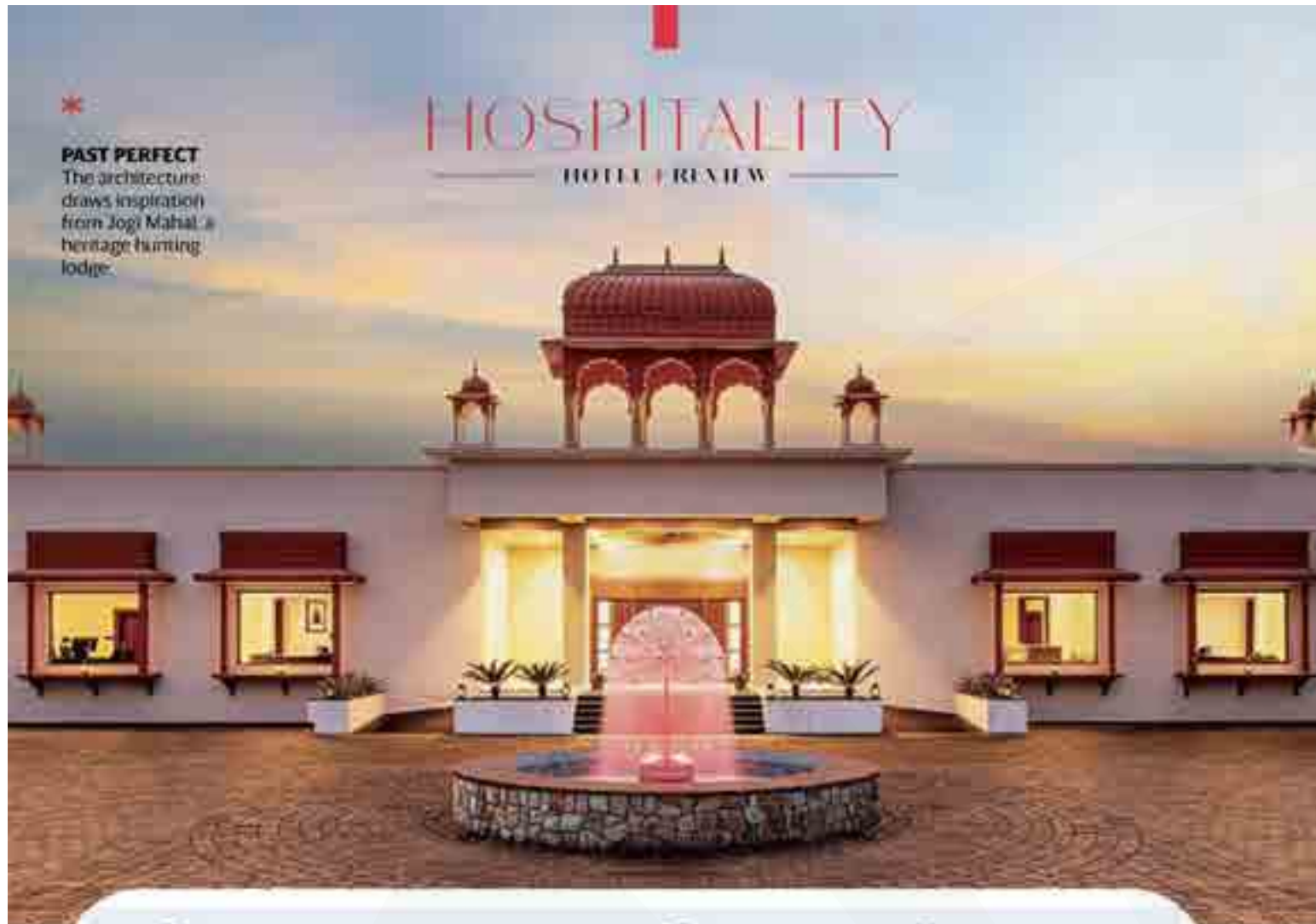
